JASWANT SINGH, J.(ORAL)

Twelve Petitioners, namely, Baldev Singh, Rajni Bala, Chaman Lal, Kulwant Singh, Rattan Chand, Kewal Krishan, Balbir Kumar, Balbir Chand, Bhagat Ram, Lashkari, Tarsem Lal and Harbans Lal claims that they are working on Daily Wage basis at different places under the Divisional Forest Officer, Faridkot, Forest Division, Sri Muktsar Sahib, Punjab since last more than 20 years. They have impugned the orders dated 23.07.2012, 31.08.2012, 29.09.2012, 19.09.2012, 17.10.2012, 19.09.2012 and 26.09.2014 Annexure P-7(Colly) whereby their claim for regularization in terms of Regularization Policy dated 18.03.2011 has been illegally rejected.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submit that claim for regularization vide the impugned speaking order dated 23.07.2012, 31.08.2012, 29.09.2012, 19.09.2012, 17.10.2012, 19.09.2012 and

26.09.2014 Annexure P-7(Colly) has been illegally rejected based on

incorrect appreciation of facts.

After hearing learned Counsel for the petitioner, no case for interference is warranted. Firstly even the civil suit concededly would be barred for challenging the order dated 23.07.2012, 31.08.2012, 29.09.2012, 19.09.2012, 17.10.2012, 19.09.2012 except for the order dated 26.09.2014 Annexure P-7(Colly) due to lapse of more than three years and qua order dated 26.09.2014 there is unexplained delay of more than 2 years and thus suffers from vice of delay and latches. Secondly the issues sought to be raised concededly are disputed question of facts, for which the writ jurisdiction cannot be invoked.

In view of the above, finding no merit in the present writ petition, the same is hereby dismissed.
