Rajesh Bindal, J.

The order dated 25.11.2015 passed by the Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana pertaining to the election on alleged consensus of the parties has been impugned. The petitioner disputes that he never consented to the passing of the order.

Mr. Lekh Raj Sharma, Advocate, appearing for respondent no.1 fairly stated that in case the petitioner is disputing his consent, respondent no.1 will withdraw the impugned order dated 25.11.2015 and will pass a fresh order.

In view of the aforesaid statement of respondent no.1, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the writ petition may be disposed as infructuous.

Ordered accordingly. The Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana shall be at liberty to pass a fresh order in terms of the applicable Rules.
