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KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

The prayer of the petitioner is for stepping up of his pay equal to his junior. It is stated that despite his retirement in the year 2011, the matter is not being decided. Even, under the Right to Information Act, 2005, the petitioner, vide letter dated 9.11.2016 (Annexure-P-6), has been informed that the entire record is being collected. The short prayer pressed at this stage is that respondents may be directed to decide his representation dated 25.4.2016 (Annexure-P-5) in a time bound manner.

In these circumstances, without issuing notice to the opposite party, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to decide the representation dated 25.4.2016 (Annexure-P-5) within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
