The petitioners are seeking direction to the respondents to regularize their services w.e.f. 01.02.1996, whereon the services of the persons junior to them have been regularized.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has drawn my attention to representation dated 27.05.2016 (Annexure P-7) sent to the respondents in this regard, which has failed to evoke any response. Learned counsel further states that he would be satisfied if the petition is disposed of with direction to the respondents to consider and decide the representation of the petitioners in a time bound manner.

Without making any observation on the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition with direction to the respondent No. 2 to consider and decide the representation of the petitioners dated dated 27.05.2016 (Annexure P-7), in accordance with law, within a period of six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
