MAHESH GROVER.J.

States that irregularities were committed by the Sarpanch in disbursing the amount for construction of toilets in the village and the name of the petitioner is also included even though he was not a claimant. The amount itself has been disbursed to a non-disclosed entity. The petitioners also allege several other irregularities in which regard he has submitted a legal notice which is on record as Annexure P-5.

At this stage, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I would deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant petition with a direction to the respondents to look into the grievance of the petitioners as contained in the legal notice Annexure P-5 and take a decision thereon in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of the order. Ordered accordingly.
