Petitioner's application for the release of his land abutting National Highway No.8 appears to be under consideration of the Competent Authority-cum-Land Acquisition Collector-cum-Sub Divisional Magistrate, Gurgaon (North). It is claimed that favourable recommendations have already been made by the Project Director, National Highway Authority of India vide memo dated 11.05.2016.
