Rajesh Bindal, J.

This order will dispose of four writ petitions bearing CWP No. 3358, 6988, 7000 and 7019 of 2014, as common questions of law and facts are involved therein.

The challenge in the present petitions is to the orders dated 30.1.2014 and 18.2.2014 passed by the District Consumer Disputes Redressal Forum, Chandigarh. It could not be disputed that against the orders impugned, the petitioners have remedy before the State Commission in terms of Section 17 of the Consumer Protection Act, 1986.

Considering the fact that the petitioners have an effective alternative remedy against the orders impugned in the present petitions, this Court would not like to interfere in the present petitions. Hence, the same are dismissed. However, this order shall not debar the petitioners from availing appropriate remedy in accordance with law.
