Two petitioners-Vijay Kumar and Davinder Kumar are stated to be working as Work Charge T-Mates at Shahpur Kandi and are claiming promotion to the post of Oiler and Cleaner (O.C.).

It is contended that vide detailed Note at **Annexure P-5**, the case of the petitioners at Item Nos.7 and 11 was recommended for promotion to the post of O.C., however, to date, the benefit has not been granted, although similarly situated co-employees have been extended the benefit of promotion. It is next contended that the petitioners have made representations dated 18.09.2015 and 31.10.2015 (**Annexures P-10 to P-12**) reiterating the redressal of their grievances. To date, no decision has been taken.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that his clients would be satisfied that if the respondents are directed to decide the representations by passing a speaking order in a time bound manner.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority/respondents to decide the aforesaid claim of the petitioners, as set out in the representations (P-10 to P-12), as also in the present writ petition in view of the recommendations at P-5 by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within four months from the receipt of the certified copy of this order along with copy of the writ petition.

Disposed of in the above terms.
