The petitioners have sought a direction to the respondents to consider and decide their representations.

It is the case of the petitioners that they were working as Conductors in the Punjab Roadways and the period of their service is to be countable for pensionary benefits. The petitioners have sent representations/legal notices dated 10.11.2016 as Annexures P-1 and P-2, respectively, which have failed to evoke any response.

Without making any observation on the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representations/legal notices dated 10.11.2016 (Annexures P-1 and P-2), sent by the petitioners, in accordance with law, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
