In the present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has prayed for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the opening of tender concerning to Scheme Bajwara (**Annexure P-2**) and Scheme Sahri (**Annexure P-8**) in favour of respondents No.4 and 5 because the petitioner is eligible for the same in view of the Notification dated 02.10.2014 (**Annexure P-4**) issued by the Department of Cooperation, Government of Punjab, but the respondents without scanning and scrutinizing the same has finalized the tender in favour of respondents No.4 and 5. Further prayer has also been made to direct the respondents to allot the tenders (**Annexures P-2 and P-8**) in favour of the petitioner.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ

petition with liberty to the petitioner to approach the authorities concerned or to avail the alternate remedy, as may be available to it in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. It shall, however, be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to it, in accordance with law.
