The petitioners are stated to be working as Class IV employees on contingent part time basis under the District Police, Government of Haryana. The petitioner No.1 is working as Sweeper since 28.07.1994 and petitioner No.2 is working as Mali since 16.08.2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are being paid at DC rates for only four hours while they are actually working for 10 to 12 hours a day. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioners are entitled to higher wages in terms of the notifications issued by the respondents which are appended as Annexures P2 to P5. In support of his submission, he has relied upon the judgments of this Court in **CWP No.1133 of 2010** titled as '**Ram Harsh and others Vs. State of Haryana and others**' decided on 19.05.2011 (Annexure P-1) and **CWP No.12745 of 2015** titled as '**Rakesh Kumar and others Vs. The State of Haryana and others**' decided on 29.01.2016 (Annexure P-8).

In the facts and circumstances of the case, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition with a direction to respondent No.3 to consider and decide the claim of the petitioners, in accordance with law, in the light of aforementioned judgments, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
