In the present petition, the petitioner was a candidate in an open Bharti recruitment Rally conducted by the Indian Army recruitment board for various posts across the country. The petitioner applied for the post of Store Keeper Technical. He had passed certain examination and also medical. Initially he was held to be medically fit. There was delay in dispatching him to the post of Store Keeper Technical. Thus, the respondents have resorted to one more medical in view of gap between the first medical and second medical which is required as per the guidelines. In the second medical, the respondents have declared the petitioner as unfit for the disability of "HYPER HYDRDSIS". Thus, on 26.9.2016, the respondents have communicated to the legal notice that the petitioner is medically unfit. The petitioner has not made out a case so as to interfere with the declaration of his candidature that the petitioner is medically unfit for the post of Store Keeper Technical.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present writ petition.

He is permitted to do so.

Writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
