ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL J. (ORAL)

The petitioner has sought a direction to the respondents to conduct the medical examination of the petitioner for verification of his age.

The petitioner is stated to have been employed by the respondents in 1981 on daily wages. He has worked with respondents till 01.09.2016, whereon, services of the petitioner were dispensed with, in view of the Government instructions fixing the maximum age of daily wagers as 60 years.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that although in the voter card, the age of the petitioner has been shown as about 73 years but the date of birth of the petitioner in Aadhar and Pan cards has been recorded as 20.10.1961 which comes to about 55 years. Learned counsel for the petitioner has further contended that the Forest Range Officer vide letter dated 18.07.2016 (Annexure P-6) has asked the petitioner to get his age verified by the Medical Board and the petitioner has also approach the Medical Board in this regard. However, the Civil

Surgeon, Jind has insisted on a written communication from the Forest Range Officer in this regard.

Issue notice to the respondents.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Rathee, Sr. DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

In these facts and circumstances of the case, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition with a direction to the Divisional Forest Officer, Jind (respondent No.3) to send a written request to the Civil Surgeon, Jind for the medical examination of the petitioner within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
