Petitioner has filed this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to correct the name of his mother in his Matriculation Certificate (Annexure -4) and Detailed Marks Sheet (Annexure P-5).

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that for redressal of his grievance, petitioner has moved representation Annexures P-8 to respondent No.2, but no action has been taken on the same so far.

Accordingly, without adverting to the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of, with a direction to respondent No.2 to dispose of the representation Annexure P-8 moved by the petitioner for redressal of his grievance by passing a speaking order expeditiously preferably within two months of the receipt of certified copy of this order.
