Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh one for the same relief as the stand taken by the respondents is that the Haryana Mechanical Vehicles (Levy of Tolls), Act 1996, will be applicable for levy of toll and not the Haryana Motor Transport Vehicles (Toll), Act 1991. The entire pleaded case of the petitioner is based on the 1991 Act.

Learned counsel for the respondents do not have any objection to the prayer being granted if the petitioner prefers a petition in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to file a fresh one for the same relief in accordance with law.
