PARAMJEET SINGH DHALIWAL, J. (ORAL)

Instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the official respondents to deliver the physical possession of the partitioned land owned by petitioner in the revenue estate of Kishanpura, Derabassi in misal No.10 of 2011 on the basis of order of partition dated 27.05.2013 passed by Assistant Collector 1st Grade, Derabassi.

In pursuance of order dated 05.05.2016, Mr. Karamjeet Singh, Naib Tehsildar, Zirakpur, is present in Court and has produced the copy of warrants of possession whereby possession has been delivered to the petitioner. Copy of the warrants of possession is taken on record.

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In view of above, present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous. However, respondents will be at liberty to raise all the pleas before the concerned authority or challenge the order of delivery of possession in accordance with law.
