At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that on the same issue, some of the similarly situated persons, namely, Bharti Gupta and others have approached this Court by way of filing ***CWP No.12023 of 2015***, which was disposed of vide order dated 29.05.2015 with a direction to the respondents to consider and decide the claim of the petitioners, as set out in the representation filed by them, in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy the order. Learned counsel for the petitioners also submits that the petitioners would be satisfied, in case, the same directions are issued by this Court as the legal notice dated 28.07.2016 (Annexure P-7) is still pending.

In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider the legal notice dated 28.07.2016 (Annexure P-7) and take necessary action thereupon in accordance with law within a period

of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

However, in case, the petitioners are found to be entitled for the relief sought for in the legal notice, the same be released to them within a period of three months thereafter.

In case, the petitioners are still aggrieved in any manner, they are at liberty to avail the appropriate remedy.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
