**RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J.**

An elaborate office order has been passed by the Director General, Treasuries & Accounts Department, Haryana, Chandigarh on August 11, 2016 which has been produced by the learned Law Officer in Court today. Copy has been handed over to Mr. Malik. He has read out the same in Court and he is satisfied that it largely settles the dispute and the petition has been rendered infructuous.

The petition stands dismissed as infructuous. However, in case, there is any grievance remaining arising out of the office order, the petitioners will be at liberty to either to approach the administrative authorities for removal of grievance or approach the Court of Law by seeking legal remedies.
