Petitioner seeks necessary correction in the name of his parents in the Matriculation certificate dated 28.05.2015 (Annexure P5) and also in the other examination forms which he has filled up for appearing in the +2 examination and resultantly, in the certificate of +2, which is to be issued in due course of time. Reliance is placed upon the birth certificate registered on 08.12.1998 (Annexure P1) wherein the date of birth of the petitioner is shown as 29.11.1998. In the said certificate, the name of the father is mentioned as 'Gurdev Singh' and the name of the mother is mentioned as 'Raj Kumari', whereas in the certificate issued by the respondent-Board, the names are mentioned as 'Gurdev Dhiman' and 'Rajkumari Dhiman'. The change is sought in consonance with the said birth certificate and also as per Annexure P2 and the identity cards issued by the Election Commission (Annexures P3 & P4).

Counsel submits that applications dated 12.09.2015 and 07.05.2016 (Annexures P6 & P7) were moved to respondent No.2. The said representations were forwarded to the respondent-Board on 10.05.2016 (Annexure P8) by the school but to no avail. Resultantly, legal notice dated 02.12.2016 (Annexure P9) was served upon the respondent-Board, for the necessary relief. Counsel further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if the same is decided in a time-bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr.Aseem Aggarwal, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-Board, at the asking of the Court.

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Accordingly, without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the decision making process is pending, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent-Board to decide the legal notice dated 02.12.2016 (Annexure P9), within a period of 6 weeks from the receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case an adverse order is to be passed, the same should contain reasons and be conveyed to the petitioner. It will be open to the respondent-Board to call upon the petitioner for any necessary document(s), if so required.
