Counsel for respondent No.3 submits that notice was issued in this case on 04.04.2014 with the observation that *“it is made clear that notice is being issued to the respondents for an out of court settlement by sending the parties to Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court”*.

It is submitted by counsel for respondent No.3 that since there is no chance of any compromise between the parties even before or outside the court, therefore, this petition may be dismissed as the notice was issued only for this purpose.
