The petitioner has preferred this writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ of mandamus for directing the respondents to hand over/taking over of the services of the petitioners in the Municipal Corporation, Amritsar as Pump Operator.

Brief facts of this case are that the petitioner was working as Pump Operator in the Water Supply and Sewerage Division, Amritsar. The said department/project alongwith staff was handed over to the Municipal Corporation, Amritsar but the Municipal Corporation has refused to take over their services.

It comes out that the petitioners have served a legal notice dated 02.09.2016 (*Annexure P-6*) upon the respondents. Now, the short prayer of the petitioner is that the respondents may be directed to decide the legal notice dated 02.09.2016 (*Annexure P-6*) within a specific time frame.

In the circumstances, the present writ petition is disposed of, without issuing notice to the respondents, with a direction to decide the

by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of
receipt of certified copy of this order.
