i.e. for impleading legal heirs of respondent No.2 and placing on record
written statement.

One application is for impleading the legal representatives
of deceased-Raghubir Singh (respondent No.2), who is stated to have
expired. The legal representatives of deceased-respondent No.2 are
mentioned in para 2 of the application. It is stated that there is no other

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legal heir of deceased-respondent No.2 except the persons mentioned in the application.

Heard.

Application is allowed, subject to all just exceptions. The persons mentioned in para 2 of the application are ordered to be impleaded as legal heirs of deceased for the limited purpose of pursuing this petition.

The other application is for placing on record written statement on behalf of respondent No.2. The same is allowed, Written statement on behalf of respondent No.2 is taken on record, subject to all just exceptions.
