Petitioner seeks necessary correction in the date of birth as '11.05.1985' instead of '11.05.1983' in the 8th class certificate, dated 29.04.1996 (Annexure P1) and 10th class certificate, dated 07.04.1999 (Annexure P2 Colly.). Reliance is placed upon the birth certificate registered on 02.01.2013 (Annexure P3) wherein the date of birth of the petitioner is shown as 11.05.1985.

Counsel submits that legal notice dated 22.08.2016 (Annexure P9) has also been served upon the respondent-Board but no action has been taken on the same. He further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if the same is decided in a time-bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr.Ajaivir Singh, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-Board, at the asking of the Court. Copy of the paperbook has been supplied to him.

Accordingly, without commenting on the merits of the case or the entitlement of the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the decision making process is pending, the present writ petition is disposed

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of, with a direction to the respondent-Board to decide the legal notice dated 22.08.2016 (Annexure P9), within a period of 2 months from the receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case an adverse order is to be passed, the same should contain reasons and be conveyed to the petitioner. It will be open to the respondent-Board to call upon the petitioner for any necessary document(s), if so required.
