Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the matching grant of Rs. 15 crores for construction of Lawyers' Chambers Ferozepur and Rs. 2 crores for raising Bar Library as per notification No. 10/30/2002. MA2(3) 5739 dated 06.08.2009 (Annexure P/1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner points out that in the reply filed by respondents No. 1 to 4, it has been mentioned that the matching grant will be released in this financial year on availability of funds and after completing the necessary formalities. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that instant writ petition may be disposed of with a direction to the respondents to do the needful within a stipulated period.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties, instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to release the

matching grant to the petitioner in accordance with law preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
