Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is not in touch with him. Even the demand draft of Rs.10,000/- which was paid by way of costs by the respondent on the last date, has not been claimed so far. Validity of the said draft has also expired and no one has come forward to fetch the same.

The information which the petitioner had sought was whether Naresh son of Sh.Rameshwar had presented an application regarding stay order granted by the Additional Civil Judge (Sr.Divn.), Sonipat from 07.04.2005 to 27.05.2008 before the Tehsildar and whether he had taken certified copy of sale deed dated 16.02.2005.

In the reply, the stand taken is that the copy of the application moved by Naresh has not been traced out within the said period and whether Naresh had obtained the copy of sale deed dated 16.02.2005 from the said office, was not in their knowledge.

It is pertinent to mention that vide communication dated

14.11.2011 (Annexure R-1), the petitioner had been informed that the stay order had been received from the Court and the copy of the same could be obtained from the record room of the concerned Court. It is apparent that the information which was sought on account of fact that the petitioner was a defendant No.7 in the suit for specific performance filed by one Rameshwar in which order of status quo had been passed on 19.05.2008.

Keeping in view the above, this court is of the opinion that whatsoever the information is in possession of the respondent, the same has been duly supplied. Even otherwise, the petitioner seems to have lost interest in the litigation. No further order is thus required to be passed in the present writ petition.

It is open to the petitioner to file an application for revalidation of the draft, if so, required or for clarification of the above said order.

Petition stands disposed of.
