1. The prayer made in this writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the house of the petitioners under Section 24(2) of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners have earlier approached this Court by way of filing **Civil Writ Petition No.26493 of 2014** which was disposed of on 29.06.2015 (Annexure P-13) with liberty to the petitioners to approach the appropriate authority by way of filing a detailed and comprehensive representation raising all the pleas as raised in the writ petition within a period of two months from the issuance of the order, the same shall be decided in accordance with law by passing a speaking order and after affording

an opportunity of hearing to them within a period of four months thereafter. He further submitted that the representation was filed by the petitioners on 13.07.2015 but till date no order has been passed whereas the stipulated period has already been elapsed. It is, thus, prayed that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioners either to move application in the earlier writ petition or to file the contempt petition for violation of the said order dated 29.06.2015.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn, It shall, however, be open to the petitioners to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to them, in accordance with law.
