The petitioners are seeking appointment to the post of Female Constable in pursuance to the advertisement issued by the respondents on 19.07.2015. It is the case of the petitioners that they are meritorious candidates and hence should have been selected by the respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has contended that the marks of the petitioners have not been disclosed by the respondents, despite their legal notice dated 21.10.2016 (Annexure P-6) sent to respondent No.3, in this regard. Learned counsel for the petitioners further contends that the result of the examination for the post of Female Constable in Haryana Police has been declared and the marks of the successful candidates have been displayed on the website.

Issue notice to the respondents.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Rathee, Sr. DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Learned counsel for the petitioners has furnished him four sets of paper book during the course of the day.

The result of the examination has been declared. The Petitioners, who are unsuccessful candidates, certainly have a right to know how they have fared in the examination and what is the breakup of the marks obtained by them.

Therefore, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to disclose the marks of the petitioners within a period of one week from now.
