KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was awarded various punishments against which he filed appeal before the Secretary, Transport Department, Punjab. Vide order dated 11.12.2012 (Annexure P-2), his punishments were reduced. However, his pension has not been revised. He issued legal notice dated 02.09.2016 (Annexure P-4).

The short prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner is that a direction may be issued to the respondents to decide the legal notice of the petitioner dated 02.09.2016 (Annexure P-4).

In view of the matter, without issuing notice to the respondents, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice of the petitioner dated 02.09.2016 (Annexure P-4) within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order by passing a speaking order.
