Petitioner seeks writ in the nature of mandamus, directing respondent No.2 to declare the result of the petitioner, after conducting the re-evaluation/ re-checking of the papers of Mathematics and Physics of 10+2 class with roll No.2016077611. It is the case of the petitioner that a sum of Rs.1820/- had been deposited at the counter with the respondent-Board on 20.05.2016 (Annexure P3) along with the application, but no action has been taken.

Counsel submits that a representation dated 13.06.2016 (Annexure P4) has been served upon the respondent-Board, followed by a reminder dated 20.09.2016 (Annexure P5) but to no avail. It is submitted that the petitioner would be satisfied if the same are decided within a time-bound frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr.S.S.Behl, Advocate, accept notice on behalf of the respondent-Board, at the asking of the Court. Copy of the paperbook has been supplied to him.

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Accordingly, without commenting on the merits of the case or the entitlement of the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is only seeking re-evaluation/ re-checking of his papers, the present writ petition is disposed of, with a direction to respondent No.3, to take action on the representation dated 13.06.2016 (Annexure P4), within a period of 2 weeks from the receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case there is any legal impediment for the request made for re-evaluation/ re-checking and the same cannot be done, the petitioner shall be given reasons as to why his request cannot be acceded to.
