The petitioners have sought a direction to the respondents to consider their claim for regularization in the light of the policy decision dated 01.10.2003 (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that a similar petition bearing CWP No. 21581 of 2016 titled as ***Rajesh Vs. State of Haryana and others***, has been disposed of by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 19.10.2016 with a direction to the respondents to consider the case of the petitioner therein, in the light of judgment in the case of ***Jai Bhagwan Vs. State of Haryana and others***, CWP No. 27024 of 2013, decided on 20.01.2016 (Annexure P-7). Learned counsel for the petitioners also states that she would be satisfied if the petition is disposed of with direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice of the petitioners dated 19.11.2016 (Annexure P-5) in the light of judgment in the case of ***Rajesh Vs. State of Haryana and others (supra)***.

Issue notice to respondents.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Rathee, learned Senior Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Without making any observation on the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition with direction to respondent No. 3 to consider and decide the legal notice of the petitioners dated 19.11.2016 (Annexure P-5), in accordance with law, keeping in view the judgment in the case of *Rajesh Vs. State of Haryana and others (supra)* and any other relevant material, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
