Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioner has approached this Court, by way of present writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that when the genuine grievance of the petitioner was not being redressed, she approached the respondent authorities by way of self-contained representation dated 18.06.2015 (Annexure P-12) but the same is also pending decision. He further submits that during this period, State of Haryana has constituted a Commission under the Chairmanship of a retired IAS Officer to look into and resolve the long outstanding issues pertaining to the membership and assets of the respondent-Society. This Commission was constituted by the State Government vide notification dated 06.06.2016 and the Commission is seized of the matter.

Learned counsel for the petitioner also submits that petitioner will be satisfied

in case the representation (Annexure P-12) of the petitioner may also be ordered to be considered and decided by the Commission constituted vide notification dated 06.06.2016, taking an appropriate action, in accordance with law.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, present writ petition is disposed of, with a direction Assistant Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Gurgaon-respondent No.3 to refer this case as well to the Commission constituted by the State Government vide notification dated 06.06.2016. After receiving the reference from Assistant Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Gurgaon-respondent No.3, the Commission shall consider the grievance of the petitioner raised in the representation dated 18.06.2015 (Annexure P-12) and decide the same, at an early date by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly in accordance with law. Let the Commission make an endeavour to decide these long outstanding issues pertaining to the respondent-Society expeditiously.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, instant writ petition stands disposed of.
