Appellant-Sandeep Kumar had filed a divorce petition against his wife Manisha before the Matrimonial Court. However, the same was dismissed vide judgment dated 14.9.2009. Sandeep (husband) filed the present appeal against the judgment of the Trial Court as referred to above. The Bench referred the matter to the Lok Adalat for exploring the possibilities of amicable settlement between the parties. Notice was issued to respondent-Manisha (wife). As per the office report, Manisha's mother had stated that Manisha is residing with her husband Sandeep in Village Aheri District Jhajjar. From the report we can assume that the matter has been settled amicably between the parties as according to the mother of respondent-Manisha, Manisha is residing with her husband. According to us, the appeal has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such. However, liberty is given to the parties to get the case revived, in accordance with law, if circumstances so exist.
