Through this application, applicant-respondent No.1 seeks to place on record written statement.

Allowed as prayed for.

Civil miscellaneous application stands disposed of.

Main case

The present petition has been filed seeking issuance of a direction to the respondents to count the service of the petitioners on daily wage basis, followed by regularization, towards pensionary benefits.

The respondents have filed a short written statement submitting therein that the competent authority has already accorded sanction to the daily wage service rendered by the petitioners, except petitioner No.3 to be counted towards their pensionary benefits rendering the present petition infructuous qua all the petitioners except petitioner No.3.

So far as petitioner No.3 is concerned, it is submitted that the

service book of petitioner No.3 being incomplete, no final order could be passed in his case.

In view of the aforesaid stand taken by the respondents, the present petition has been rendered infructuous qua petitioners No.1 and 2 and 4 to 11.

Ordered accordingly.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner No.3 whose case has not been finalized has expired on 28.2.2015. That being so, his legal representatives are granted liberty to approach respondent No.3 to complete the service particulars of petitioner No.3.

After the needful has been done by the legal representatives of petitioner No.3, respondent No.3 is directed to take final decision thereupon within three months.

Disposed of accordingly.
