Counsel for the appellant has expressed his inability to comply with order dated 10.3.2016 whereby the appellant was provided one more opportunity to comply with order dated 6.2.2015 subject to costs of

Rs. 2,000/- to be deposited with the High court Legal Services Authority, Chandigarh.

The appellant has neither deposited the costs nor complied with the order. As a result, the appeal against respondent No. 1 is ordered to be dismissed.

The present appeal has been directed against award dated 10.2.2011 whereby the petition filed by Hem Raj appellant for grant of compensation in respect of injuries sustained by him in a motor vehicular accident on 12.10.2005 was dismissed by the Tribunal. As the appeal has been dismissed against respondent no. 1, the driver and owner of the alleged offending vehicle, the insurance company, in these circumstances, cannot be fastened with any liability to pay compensation. That being so, the appeal is ordered to be dismissed.
