

**Smt.Kavita Devi and ors. Vs. Rakam Singh and ors.**

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Mr.Dinesh Kumar, proxy counsel has appeared on behalf of Mr.R.S.Madan, Advocate and states that Mr.R.S.Madan is no more counsel for respondent No.3 – Insurance Company. Today, another counsel, Mr.Subhash Goyal, has appeared on behalf of respondent No.3 – Insurance Company and has filed Memo of Appearance.

The matter has been discussed. As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellants and learned counsel for the Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of ₹3,50,000/- (₹ Three Lac Fifty Thousand Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount be paid to appellant No.1 – Smt.Kavita Devi widow of Satnarayan.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed – cheque for ₹3,50,000/- in the name of appellant No.1 – Smt.Kavita Devi widow of Satnarayan with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 06.05.2016, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellant(s)' counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
