After arguing for some time, counsel does not wish to press the present petition in view of the fact that the Civil Suit had been filed claiming the same relief for compassionate appointment which is now being claimed and the same already stands dismissed on 1.12.2015. Counsel prays that the present writ petition may be dismissed as not pressed with liberty to avail alternative remedy.

In such circumstances, once the petitioner opted for a specific remedy this court is of the opinion that it is not permissible for him to change the forum mid way.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is dismissed as not pressed with liberty to avail alternative remedy in accordance with law.
