The grievance of the petitioner is that front portion of the property of the petitioner abutting the road, which is part of the public street has been encroached upon by respondents No. 5 to 7. Earlier Dilawar Chand had encroached that land, however, it was got vacated. Now his successors-in-interest have constructed wooden khokhas. Despite his representation, no action has been taken by the authorities.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No. 2 to examine the claim of the petitioner regarding encroachment on the public land by respondents no. 5 to 7 and in case it is so, take appropriate action for vacation of the public property. The needful be done within three months from the date of receipt of copy of the order.
