SURYA KANT, J.

(1) The controversy in this case pertains to the validity of acquisition of the land made by the State of Haryana through notifications dated 01.04.2010 and 04.04.2011 issued under Sections 4&6 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894, respectively vide which a huge chunk of land comprising the revenue estate of various villages has been acquired for the development of Industrial Model Township (IMT) at Kharkhauda. Respondent No.3 – HSIIDC has separately moved an application for dismissal of this writ petition *qua* petitioners No.2 to 4, 7 to 16, 20 to 22, 24 to 26, 28 to 31, 33 to 42, 44 to 54, 58 to 65 on the plea that all of them have received the compensation.

(2) Vide separate order of even date passed in **CWP No.5863 of 2013** titled as **Brahm Dev @ Balbir Singh & Ors. vs.State of Haryana & Ors.**, we have upheld the acquisition though with certain directions for resettlement and rehabilitation of the affected landowners. The claim of each petitioner in this case including those who have received the compensation shall accordingly be determined by the Corporation/State Government in the light of those directions.

(3) Ordered accordingly.
