The petitioner is FCI Workers Union, District Sangrur through its member Paramjeet Singh presented this petition seeking writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.2 to 4 to ensure the safety and security of the workers of petitioners union from members of respondents No.5 and 6 as also directing respondents No.2 to 4 to take legal action on the legal notice dated 6.03.2014 (Annexure P-6).

The petitioner's though office is situated in Ahmedgarh, District Sangrur whereas place of working and godown is in the territorial jurisdiction of district Ludhiana. Therefore, the representation and legal notice relating to grievance of the petitioner's union was submitted to respondents No.1 to 4. Respondents No.3 and 4 are directed to consider the legal notice submitted by the petitioner's union and take necessary action in accordance with law and also communicate the action taken by them. The petitioner's union as well as respondents No.5 and 6 are directed to co-

operate with respondents No.3 and 4 whenever the presence of the petitioner and respondents No.5 and 6 are necessary for the purpose of extending safety and security of the workers of the petitioner's union. Respondents No.3 and 4 are directed to take action with reference to legal notice within a period of two months from today.

Disposed of accordingly.
