RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J. (Oral)

It would not be possible for this Court to hold that the period of service spent from May 01, 1976 to January 31, 1978 as a Research Assistant would count for qualifying service for pension and retiral benefits. While working as a Research Assistant, the petitioner was on a fixed salary of Rs.800/- per month and that too in a scheme and therefore he cannot be regarded as a Government servant during this period for the purpose of adding this period with the remaining service as a Medical Officer for purposes of pension. The aforesaid period is not countable towards pension which prayer is declined against the petitioner.

The petition stands dismissed.
