The petitioner prays that 7 FIRs are pending against respondent No.5-Sarpanch and he cannot continue on the post. In this regard the petitioner has made a representation to initiate action against the said respondent under the Panchayati Raj Act, 1994 which has gone unheeded.

At this stage, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I would deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant petition with a direction to the official respondents to look into the grievance of the petitioner as contained in the representation Annexure P-2 and take a decision thereon in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. Ordered accordingly.
