SABINA, J

Petitioner has filed this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of Certiorari challenging the order dated 12.01.2016 (Annexure P-4), whereby, the petitioner has been transferred from the office of Deputy Director of Factories, Circle-II, Jalandhar to Industrial Tribunal, Jalandhar.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record available on the file carefully.

The case of the petitioner, in brief, is that he was adjusted as a Peon with Industrial Tribunal, Jalandhar on 13.12.2010 and was transferred to the office of Deputy Director of Factories, Circle-II, Jalandhar. Petitioner was asked to do household work by the Deputy Director of

Factories, Circle-I, Jalandhar. When the petitioner declined to do such work, he was harassed by the said officer and due to this reason, he had been transferred. Petitioner was suffering from high blood pressure and was a diabetic.

In the present case, petitioner has been transferred from one office to the other in Jalandhar. In these circumstances, it cannot be said to be a case of hardship for the petitioner as he has to work in the same city, but in a different Department.

No ground for interference by this Court while exercising the jurisdiction under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is made out.

Dismissed.
