The petitioner-College seeks the release/ reimbursement of 95% grant-in-aid qua the dues of staff as already paid by the petitioner-privately managed Government aided college, to the retired teaching/non-teaching staff, as mentioned in legal notice dated 18.10.2015 (Annexure P6) wherein payment has been made to 3 employees, to the tune of Rs.30,00,000/-.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to decide the demand notice dated 18.10.2015 (Annexure P6) within a time-bound frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr.R.S.Sidhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Copy of the paperbook has been supplied to him.

Keeping in view the limited relief sought, this Court does not feel it necessary to ask the respondents to file reply.

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of, with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide the demand notice dated 18.10.2015 (Annexure P6), within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. The authorized representative of the petitioner-College shall be present in the office of respondent No.3 along with all necessary documents between 01.03.2016 to 03.03.2016. In case the payments are found due, same will be made within a period of 4 weeks, thereafter. In case the same is to be denied, a speaking order be passed and the same be conveyed to the petitioner.
