Petitioner has filed this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 19.07.2011 (Annexure P-3).

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record available on the file carefully.

Tirath Ram father of the petitioner was working with the respondents. Tirath Ram died on 28.01.2008. Petitioner moved an application to respondent No.6 for his appointment on compassionate basis. The case of the petitioner was recommended by respondent No.6 for his appointment in Class-IV category. The claim of the petitioner was rejected vide order dated 19.07.2011 (Annexure P-3). A perusal of the said order reveals that the

claim of the petitioner was rejected on the ground that there was no vacancy within the ceiling limit of 5% of the direct recruit quota. Further, it was also noticed that the respondents-Corporation had released ₹12,72,000/- by way of terminal dues to the family and family was having its own residential house. The order was passed way-back on 19.07.2011, whereas, the petitioner has sought to challenge the said order by filing the present writ petition in February 2016.

On account of delay and latches, no ground for interference by this Court while exercising the jurisdiction under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is made out.
