The petitioner has approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, challenging the impugned action of the respondents in taking possession of the land of the petitioner illegally and without any authority of law. It is also urged that the same is in violation of Sections 4, 6, 9, 11A and 16 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 (for brevity 'the Act') and also to Article 14 of the Constitution of India.

2. The writ petition raises disputed question of fact regarding the possession of land, which can only be determined by the Civil Court. Accordingly, we dismiss the present writ petition by relegating the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to him before the appropriate Forum in accordance with law.
