The grievance of the petitioner is relating to grant of pension. The petitioner joined Indian Air Force as a Wireless Operator Mechanic. He was discharged on 30.04.1976. He is claiming pension. The service conditions of the army persons/air force persons lies before the Armed Force Tribunal under the AFT Act, 2007. Therefore, the present writ petition is not maintainable before this Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to approach the Armed Force Tribunal.

The petitioner has spent three years before this Court. If necessary application is made before the Armed Force Tribunal for condonation of delay, the same may be considered sympathetically.
