Through the present petition, on the death of his father in harness, the petitioner seeks appointment on compassionate basis.

On the last date of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner had produced letter dated 29.01.2016, addressed by the Chief Secretary, Government of Haryana to Deputy Commissioner, Hisar, ordering the petitioner's appointment as a Clerk on compassionate basis. The letter is taken on record and Annexure Mark 'A'.

Since the afore-referred letter had been issued by the Chief Secretary, Government of Haryana on 29.01.2016 and even after the passage of three months no appointment had been offered to the petitioner, I had asked the learned State counsel to seek instructions as to why there was delay in issuance of the appointment letter to the petitioner.

Today, Mr.Harish Rathee, Senior DAG, Haryana, submits that in pursuance to the letter dated 29.01.2016, referred to above, on 04.04.2016 orders have been passed by the Deputy Commissioner, Hisar for verification of the antecedents of the petitioner as also for verification of his educational qualification certificates submitted by him. He further submits that the process of verification would be completed within three months from today and if everything is found in order, the petitioner would be issued appointment letter without any delay thereafter.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner expresses satisfaction and on such expression of satisfaction, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Ordered accordingly.
