The petitioner challenges order dated 20.12.2012 (Annexure P/18) whereby a fresh complaint bearing No.194 dated 13.12.2012 was initiated against him.

On 11.1.2016, the following order was passed:-

Counsel for the State, on instructions from Kuldip Singh, Inspector, Vigilance Bureau, Moga, points out that the petitioner has superannuated on 01.01.2014 and prays for time to file short affidavit as to what is the latest status on the fact finding inquiries and on the retiral dues of the petitioner.

Adjourned to 06.05.2016.

Photocopy of the order be placed on the file of connected case.”

In pursuance of said order, an affidavit of Mr. Makhan Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Vigilance Bureau, Shri Muktsar Sahib, Addl. Charge, Vigilance Bureau, Ferozepur Range, Ferozepur on behalf of respondents no.1 to 3 has been filed.

In the said affidavit, it has been deposed that allegations of purchasing property more than his income by the petitioner has not been

proved and formal complaint has been filed and consigned to office of Vigilance Bureau vide letter dated 8.3.2016 (Annexure R/1).

Counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of said affidavit he does not wish to press the present writ petition and prays that the same may be dismissed as not pressed.
