RITU BAHRI, J.

The petitioners are seeking direction to the respondents to allow them (petitioners) to work as Sweepers and not to compel them to perform the duties of 'Chowkidar.'

Grievance of the petitioners is that the respondents have appointed them on the posts of Sweeper-cum-Chowkidar, whereas there is no post of the said nomenclature in the Punjab Civil Services Rules. The petitioners are compelled to be present on duty for 24 hours. In this regard, the petitioners have sent a legal notice dated 19.11.2015 (Annexure P-1) to the respondents, but no action has been taken thereon till date.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of by giving a direction to the respondents to look into the legal notice dated 19.11.2015 (Annexure P-1) and pass appropriate order in accordance with law, within a period of three months.
