The petitioner seeks the benefit of appointment in Government job on account of acquisition of land for Peona Thermal Power Plant at village Gobindpura as per policy dated 8.11.2011 (Annexure P-1). In the reply, the plea taken is that concealment is there as the petitioner has withdrawn her claim in favour of her brother whose case has been recommended for job.

The case of the petitioner was considered as per the Committee formed by the Government in the light of the proceedings dated 28.2.2014 (Annexure R-1) which has reported that the application has been withdrawn in favour of brother-Kuldip Singh. Neither Kuldip Singh has been made party nor any challenge has been made to the decision making in his favour.

In such circumstances, once one family member has been offered the concession of appointment, no case is made out to issue directions in favour of the petitioner. Even the writ petition has been filed

by concealing the material facts which would be another factor for not entertaining the same.

The petition is dismissed.
